Donald J. "D.J." Brennan Jr., 50, of Lake Jackson, Texas, died Friday, July 4, 2008, following a motorcycle accident. He was born October 19, 1957, in Point Pleasant, New Jersey, to Donald and Anne Brennan. A former resident of Point Pleasant, New Jersey, graduating from Point Pleasant Borough High School in 1975, D.J. entered the U.S. Army in 1976 and served in Korea.
